I declare that during the Event my self-propelled exhibit will be covered by the minimum insurance requirements of the Road Traffic Act irrespective of whether my exhibit is licensed for use on the public highway or not, If my exhibit is not self-propelled it will be covered by a Public Liability Policy and by a Boiler Explosion Policy. Both Policies have a limit of indemnity of not less than £5,000,000 any one accident, and Sparks and Ashes cover for not less than £250,000.

I further declare that the boiler of any steam plant entered carries a current Boiler Inspection Certificate and that I will produce documentary evidence of such Insurance and Inspection to you before participating in the event. I further declare that the driver(s) hold a driving licence of the appropriate class and will produce, if required, such a licence and that the driver(s) have read the NTET Traction Engine Code of Practice.

I agree to produce, on request, an Inspection certificate in accordance with the IEE Regulations for any electrical equipment (ie generators, wiring, appliances). I agree to abide by the Code of Practice of the National Traction Engine Trust and the Society’s written Statement of Safety Policy. I agree to operate my exhibit during the Event and comply with the instructions of stewards. In the event of a dispute the Event Organisers decision is final.

Conditions of Entry .

The Torbay Steam Rally Association are pleased that you have applied for an entry form for the 2022 Steam Fair to be held on the above date at Churston Ferrers, Brixham.TQ5 0JT.

This year the show is moving to a new site which is on the opposite side of the Kennels Road, the main entrance is approx 100 yds on the right past the old showground entrance.

The show will be held as usual as an approved National Traction Engine Trust Rally and comply with the NTET Code of Practice.

On signing the Entry form you are agreeing to the NTET code of practice and to following the onsite conditions and the instructions of our Marshalls. You are also agreeing to have your exhibit on site between the hours of 9.30am and 5.00pm each day. Further you are agreeing to the non movement of vehicles on site during opening hours unless under the supervision of a Marshall, and in the event of wet weather a site no movement order. Failure to comply with these conditions will in most cases result in refusal of future entry.

Dogs are allowed but must be on a lead and cleaned up after, this is farmers land. Failure to abide by this rule will mean non acceptance for future shows.

Instructions on Entry to the site and Exhibit positioning will be sent with your pass.

There may be some circumstances unfortunately when Entries cannot be accepted. If this is the case we will inform you by email or phone at the time the passes are mailed. Except in exceptional circumstances entries will close on 30th June 2022
