Public Camping Terms and Conditions

By submitting a camping booking application, you agree to the following Terms and Conditions.

1. Booking and Occupancy

- Camping fees are charged from the day of arrival.
- Pitches must be vacated by **10:00am on the day of departure**.
- A minimum stay of **two nights** applies.
- Pitches may only be occupied by the individuals named on the booking form.
- Day visitors are welcome but must pay the applicable show admission fee.
- Visitors are not permitted to stay overnight on the campsite without prior authorisation from the organisers.

2. Vehicles and Site Access

- The site speed limit is **5 mph** and must be strictly observed.
- All vehicles brought onto the site must be roadworthy and appropriately insured. Where applicable, vehicles must hold valid tax and MOT certification.
- Only drivers holding a valid driving licence and appropriate insurance may operate vehicles on site.
- Quad bikes, monkey bikes, and similar vehicles are not permitted.
- The pitch fee includes one caravan, motorhome, or tent together with one towing vehicle.
- Additional vehicles will be charged in accordance with the published tariff.
- Commercial vehicles, vans, transit vans, and pickup trucks are not permitted on site, including towing vehicles, unless prior permission has been granted by the Camping Marshal.
- No pitch may be used in connection with any trade, business, or commercial activity.

3. Dogs and Livestock Protection

- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at all times and must not be left unattended.
- Dog owners are responsible for immediately cleaning up after their dogs.
- The campsite is located on active grazing land. Failure to clean up after your dog may result in:
 - Cancellation of your booking;

- Removal from the site; and/or
 - Refusal of entry to future events.
- These requirements are necessary to protect livestock and to ensure that dogs can continue to be permitted at future shows.

4. Waste and Environmental Responsibility

- As the site is situated on grazing land, all litter must be disposed of responsibly.
- Please use the bins provided for all rubbish and waste.
- Cigarette ends must not be discarded on the ground.
- Chemical toilets must only be emptied at the designated on-site Elsan disposal points.

5. Fire Safety

- Barbecues must be raised off the ground and attended at all times.
- Following periods of prolonged dry weather, the organisers reserve the right to prohibit the use of barbecues.
- Open fires are strictly prohibited.
- All caravans and motorhomes must carry a suitable fire extinguisher in good working order.

6. Camping Facilities

- Camping pitches are basic and access is via grassed areas. Visitors should take this into account when booking.

7. Entertainment and Showground Safety

- Entertainment for campers, invited guests and exhibitors will be provided:
 - Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings until midnight; and
 - Friday, Saturday and Sunday afternoons.
- Thursday evening is **Pirate Night**, and all pirates are welcome to attend.

For safety reasons:

- Children must not play on or around exhibits.
- Children remain the responsibility of their parent or guardian at all times.
- Even after the show has closed to the public, steam engines may remain hot and/or under steam.
- Vehicles and machinery may continue to move around the showground outside public opening hours.

8. Liability

The organisers, members of the Torbay Steam Rally Association and the landowners accept no responsibility or liability for:

- Loss of or damage to any vehicle, caravan, motorhome, tent, equipment or personal possessions; or

- Any accident, injury, loss or damage suffered by campers, members of their party, visitors or their property,

howsoever caused.

All persons enter and camp on the site entirely at their own risk.

Nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall exclude or limit liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, or any other liability which cannot be excluded by law.

9. Show Admission Requirements

- All campers must purchase valid Torbay Steam Fair admission tickets for each day they are present on site whilst the show is open to the public.
- Show admission tickets must be purchased separately and in advance for each person.
- Discounted admission rates are only available for individuals named on the original booking.
- Any additional persons will be charged the full applicable admission rate.

10. Cancellations and Refunds

- If a confirmed camping booking is cancelled by the customer, **50% of the camping fee** will be refunded.
- If the Torbay Steam Fair is cancelled, **75% of the camping fee paid** will be refunded upon return of all relevant paperwork and passes.

11. Arrival Times

Access to the camping area is available between:

- **8:00am and 10:00am**, or
- **5:00pm and 7:00pm**

unless alternative arrangements have been agreed in advance with the Camping Marshal.

12. Consideration for Other Campers

All campers are expected to behave in a considerate manner and show respect to fellow campers, exhibitors, volunteers and event staff at all times.

- Excessive noise, anti-social behaviour, abusive language, or conduct likely to cause nuisance to others will not be tolerated.
- Quiet hours operate between **11:00pm and 7:00am**. During this period, noise should be kept to a minimum.
- Generators may only be operated between **7:00am and 11:00pm**, unless prior permission has been obtained from the Camping Marshal.
- Generators must be suitably silenced and not cause unreasonable disturbance to neighbouring pitches.
- Music and other amplified sound must be kept at a reasonable level at all times and must not cause disturbance to neighbouring pitches.

The organisers reserve the right to require any person causing disturbance or nuisance to leave the site without refund.

13. Right to Refuse Admission

The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to, or require the removal of, any person whose behaviour is considered unsafe, abusive, disruptive, or contrary to these Terms and Conditions.

No refund shall be payable in such circumstances.

14. Photography and Filming

Photography and filming may take place during the event for promotional, historical and archival purposes.

By entering the event, visitors consent to being photographed or filmed. Anyone with concerns regarding this should speak to an event organiser.

15. Privacy and Data Protection

The information provided on your booking form will be used solely for the administration and operation of the Torbay Steam Fair campsite and related event activities.

Personal information will be processed in accordance with applicable UK data protection legislation and will not be shared with third parties except where required for the administration of the event or by law.

By submitting a booking application, you consent to the Torbay Steam Rally Association holding and processing your personal information for these purposes.

16. Acceptance of Terms

Submission of a booking application and entry onto the campsite constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

Please retain a copy of these Terms and Conditions and bring them with you to the Torbay Steam Fair.
